\*AFFIRMATION OF FAITH (Confession of 1967, 9.32-9.33) The life, death, resurrection, and promised coming of Jesus Christ have set the pattern for the church's mission. His life as man involves the church in the common life of men. His service to men commits the church to work for every form of human well-being. His suffering makes the church sensitive to all the sufferings of mankind so that it sees the face of Christ in the faces of men in every kind of need. His crucifixion discloses to the church God's judgment on man's inhumanity to man and the awful consequences of its own complicity in injustice.


